Tools and Adhesive: Multipurpose Liquid Glue, Stampin' Trimmer, Scissor Snips, Foam Adhesive

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Instructions -

Step 1 - Cut a piece of DSP, 4-1/2" \times 6". Score along the 6" side at the 3" mark. Fold piece in half.



Step 2 - Stamp the butterfly image onto the front of the card so the tips of the wings are stamped 'off the edge' of the fold.



Step 3 - Using a pair of Scissor Snips, cut around the outer edge of the butterfly image through both layers, making sure the wings stay joined together at the top edge.




Step 4 - Score through the middle, horizontal section of the top butterfly and fold down the lower section as shown.



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Step 5 - Stamp another butterfly image onto a piece of DSP $(4-1/2" \times 3-1/4")$ and cut it out with Scissor Snips, including the antennae.

Step 7 - Stamp a small sentiment; cut it out and add a small strip of Foam Adhesive Strips to the back.

Step 8 - Stick the sentiment to the middle section of the card base to form an easel for the butterfly.





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
