

## 'PEACEFUL BOUGHS' POP-UP PLANTER BOX CARD

## Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Stamps: Peaceful Boughs
- Inks: Shaded Spruce, Early Espresso, Cherry Cobbler
- Cardstock: Thick Whisper White, Shaded Spruce, Cherry Cobbler,

## Crumb Cake, Gold Foil Sheets

- **Designer Paper:** Wrapped in Plaid Specialty, Come to Gather
- Accessories: Red Rhinestones, Braided Linen Trim
- Dies/Tools: Beautiful Boughs & In the Woods Dies, Paper Trimmer, Die-

Cutting Machine, Multi-purpose Liquid Glue, Stampin' Dimensionals, Glue Dots

• **Miscellaneous:** Whisper White Envelope

## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. Cut a 'Landscape' Card Base from half a piece of Thick Whisper White, Lettersize or A4 Card Stock. Score halfway so the fold is at the top.
- 2. Cut two pieces of 'Wrapped in Plaid' DSP (H) 4" x (W) 5-1/4" or (H) 10 cm x (W) 14.4 cm. Glue one to the front of the card base and one to the inside (top) as shown.



3. Cut **2** pieces of Woodgrain Paper from the 'Come to Gather' DSP Pack (H) 1-1/2" x (W) 11" **or** (H) 4cm x (W) 27.2cm. Glue the two pieces together so the woodgrain is on the reverse side as well.



- 4. Score along the width at –
- 1", 1-1/2", 2", 6", 6-1/2", 7" or
- 2.4cm, 3.6cm, 4.8cm, 14.8cm, 16cm, 17.2cm
- 5. Bring the ends together and glue the 1" (2.4cm) flap to the back of the planter box.



6. Glue the back of the planter box to the lower edge of the inside DSP -







7. Die-cut two Cherry Cobbler sprigs from 'In the Woods' Dies. Using the dies from 'Beautiful Boughs', cut three single and one medium bough from Gold Foil, two large, three medium and one single bough from Shaded Spruce Card Stock. Die-cut four small pinecones (Early Espresso Ink on Crumb Cake Card Stock). Tie two small bows from Braided Linen Trim. Some of the die cuts will be used to embellish the front of the card. Optional: For added detail, stamp the Shaded Spruce boughs with the single bough stamp and the Cherry Cobbler sprigs with the small pinecone stamp.







8. Use glue or Glue Dots to attach the foliage to the back and front of the planter box. Suggested placement – Back: Two medium and one single Shaded Spruce, two single gold boughs. Front: One large Shaded Spruce and one medium gold bough, one Cherry Cobbler sprig, two pinecones and bow.





- 9. Glue a strip of 'Wrapped in Plaid' DSP that is 5-1/4" or 14.4 cm wide to the lower card base. The height will vary according to the stripes in the tartan.
- 10. Adhere the stamped and die-cut sentiment to the middle of the DSP strip.





11. Embellish the front of the card with the other die-cuts and sentiment. To complete the project, stamp an image on the envelope.





Try this design with a different DSP and colour palette.
