Supplies:

Stamp Sets: Yummy Christmas, Cuckoo For You Ink: Memento Tuxedo Black, Real Red, Call Me Clover

Stampin' Blends Combo Packs: Crumb Cake, Real Red, Call Me Clover, Cherry Cobbler, Old Olive, Daffodil Delight, Soft Suede, Gray Granite, Card Stock: Crumb Cake, Thick Whisper White,

Call Me Clover
Punch: Sprig
Dies: Cuckoo Clock

Tools & Adhesives: Clear Wink of Stella Glitter Brush, Multipurpose Liquid Glue, Glue Dots, Tear & Tape Adhesive, Paper Trimmer/Scoring Board, Die

Cutting Machine



Instructions:

- Cut a piece of Crumb Cake Card Stock
 (H) 1-1/4" x (W) 6-3/4".
- 2. Score along the long side at the 2", 3-1/4", 5-1/4", 6-1/2" marks.
- 3. Fold all the score lines to form a rectangular 3D base as shown.
- 4. Glue the 1/2" end flap to the inside.
- 5. Stamp the Gingerbread House onto *Thick*Whisper White Card Stock with Tuxedo
 Memento Black Ink.
- 6. Colour in with a variety of Stampin'

 Blends. Add some Clear Wink of Stella to
 the bow on the wreath and to the snow.
- 7. Die cut with the coordinating *Cuckoo Clock Die*.
- 8. Glue the rectangular base to the front of the Gingerbread House as shown.

9. Die cut another clock/house piece from Crumb Cake Card Stock and glue to the back of the rectangular piece making sure the base of the card sits flat.









The card front will fold down as shown

- 10. Cut a piece of Crumb Cake Card Stock
 (H) 1" x (W) 3" and score in ½" from each end. Fold as shown and add some Tear & Tape Adhesive to the outside of the tabs.
- 11. Attach this insert to the middle of the card as shown making sure that the end flaps are attached to the sides and the insert stays straight when the card is folded downwards.



12. If you have the cute deer stamp from Cuckoo For You, stamp the image with Memento Tuxedo Black onto Thick Whisper White Card Stock and colour with Soft Suede, Gray Granite and Real Red Stampin' Blends. Add some Clear Wink of Stella Glitter to the nose. Glue to the top of the back section as shown.









- 13. Stamp the 'TIS THE SEASON' sentiment with *Tuxedo Black Ink* to the card back (Might be a good idea to do this bit before attaching the back piece to the rectangular base ©).
- 14. Stamp the 'yummy' sentiment with *Real Red Ink* onto *Whisper White Card Stock*, fussy cut and glue between the lines.
- 15. Punch out three sprigs from Call Me Clover Card Stock and cut each piece in half. Use these half sprigs to attach your stamped images to the box insert and card front using Glue Dots.
- 16. Stamp, colour and die cut -
 - 2 Christmas Trees
 - 3 jubes
 - 1 Mistletoe
 - 2 round candies
- 17. Placement:

Back - Tree, Deer, Tree. Middle Insert - Green Jube, Red Jube, Round Candy Front - Mistletoe, Round Candy, Yellow Jube











18. Stamp a Christmas Tree onto the envelope with *Call Me Clover Ink* and colour in if desired.



Card will fold down flat and fit easily into a standard card size envelope for posting.



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
