Supplies:

Stamp Set: Prized Peony

Ink: Basic Gray, Flirty Flamingo, Calypso Coral,

Granny Apple Green

Stampin' Blends: Granny Apple Green, Daffodil

Delight

Card Stock: Thick Whisper White, Whisper White, Shimmery White, Flirty Flamingo

DSP: Peony Garden
Dies: Hippo & Friends

Other: Elegant Faceted Gems, Dainty

Diamonds 3D Embossing Folder

Tools & Adhesives: Multipurpose Liquid Glue, Glue Dots, Stampin' Dimensionals, Paper Trimmer, Die Cutting Machine, Water Painter



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Cutting Measurements:

Card Base - (Thick Whisper White)

(H)5-1/2" × (W)11" DSP - (H)5-1/4" × (W)2-1/2" (X2), (H)5-1/4" × (W) 5-1/4" (x1)

Instructions:

 Score the Thick Whisper White Card Stock along the width at -2-3/4" and 5-1/2".

L-R: Mountain Fold the first score line, Valley Fold the second.

- 2. Glue on the DSP panels to each section.
- 3. With the largest 'roundish' label die from Hippo & Friends, die-cut a 'label' from Flirty Flamingo Card Stock and emboss with the Dainty Diamonds 3D Embossing Folder. Attach the left side of the label to the card front with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 4. Die-cut another label the same size from Basic Gray Peony Garden DSP.

Make sure that when the card is closed, the Basic Gray label sits directly underneath the front Flirty Flamingo label. Glue in place.










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- 'Stamp off' the peony image onto some scratch paper before stamping it onto a piece of Whisper White Card Stock using Calypso Coral Ink.
- 6. Stamp a sentiment over the peony with Basic Gray Ink and then die-cut using the middle-sized die. Glue to the DSP mat.
- 7. Die-cut another Whisper White label using the medium-sized die and emboss with the Dainty Diamonds 3D Embossing Folder. Glue to the front Flirty Flamingo mat.
- 8. Die-cut the peony flower pieces from Shimmery White Card Stock. Water paint the flower pieces with Flirty Flamingo Ink and Calypso Coral Ink around the edges.
- Colour the die-cut leaves with Dark and Light Granny Apple Green Stampin' Blends. Colour the stamen die-cut with a Light Daffodil Delight Stampin' Blend.
- Assemble the peony, adding Mini Stampin' Dimensionals between each layer and attach the assembled flower to the front label with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 11. Attach a few Elegant Faceted Gems across the three panels of the card.







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Ta Dah! You've now completed your Z-Fold Card. It will fold 'flattish' and fit inside a square envelope (non-SU).

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
