Made For You - Extended Double Z-Fold Card

Supplies -

Stamp Sets: Pot Pourri (The Greetery), Broadsheet Alphabet (Retired SU), So Sentimental (SU), His & Hers (Catherine Pooler Designs)

Card Stock: Rococo Rose (12x12), Shimmery White, Very Vanilla, Garden Green, Mossy Meadow, Mint Macaron, Pear Pizzazz, Gray Granite, Champagne Foil (SU)

Patterned Paper: In Good Taste DSP (SU)

Ink: Early Espresso, Gray Granite, Garden Green, Shaded Spruce (SU)

Dies: Macro Made For You & Macro Made Fillers Dies (The Greetery), Parlor Palm Die Set (Altenew), Nature's Thoughts, Peony, Little Treat Box, Tasteful Labels (SU) Other: Subtle and Pinewood Planks Embossing Folders (SU), Adhesive Pearls and Rhinestones, Very Vanilla Envelope Tools and Adhesive: Paper Cutter, Die-cutting Machine, Multipurpose Liquid Glue, Double-sided Adhesive Tape, Mini Glue Dots, Foam Adhesive Squares

A. Card Base (Rococo Rose) –

Extended Double Z-Fold Box Card Template
Card Base - (H) 5-1/4" x (W) 12"

B. Top Z-Fold Piece (Rococo Rose) –

Z-Fold Piece for an Extended Double Z-Fold Card
(H) 1-1/4" x (W) 8"

C. Box Insert (Rococo Rose) –

(H) 1-1/4" x (W) 3"



- 1. Background 'Pink Paint' Patterned Paper (In Good Taste DSP) (H)5" \times (W)3–3/4" (\times 3), (H)5" \times (W)1–3/4" (\times 2)
- 2. 'Woodgrain Panels' Patterned Paper (In Good Taste DSP) (H)5" × (W)1" (x1) for Card Front (H)1" × (W)2" (x3), (H)1" × (W)4" (x1) for

Top Z-Fold Piece and Box Insert

3. Plus extra card stock (listed in supplies) for die-cuts.

Instructions -

- 1) Score the Rococo Rose Card Base (A) along the width at 4", 8" and 10".
- L-R: Valley fold the first and second score lines and mountain fold the third score line.
 - 2) Score the Top Z-Fold Piece (B) along the width at 2" and 4". L-R: Valley fold the first score line and mountain fold the second.
 - Score the Box Insert (C) along the width at ½" and 2-1/2". Mountain fold the first score line and valley fold the second. Attach some Double-Sided Adhesive Tape to the outside tabs.
 - 4) Glue all the 'Pink Paint' patterned paper pieces to the sections of the card base as shown.







5) Glue the woodgrain paper to the top z-fold section and box insert as shown.



6) Attach the box insert tabs to the inside L & R sides of the top, open box section as shown in the photo. Make sure the insert sits flat when this 'box' section is swung towards the left to 'close' the card.






7) Glue a rectangular die-cut with a sentiment (So Sentimental - SU) to the inside-left of the card base. I used Early Espresso Ink on Shimmery White Card Stock and die-cut using the die from Nature's Thoughts (SU).



8) Optional: Add a die-cut ring (Champagne Foil, Little Treat Box Dies from SU). Fill up the 'prong setting' of the ring with Rhinestones (SU) to add some sparkle.



- Add a scallop die-cut edge to the front of the card (Shimmery White Card Stock, Peony Dies from SU).
- 10) Glue the last strip of woodgrain paper against the edge of the scallop die-cut.



- 12) Attach the largest macramé hanging pot with foam adhesive squares and glue (Macro Made For You & Macro Made Fillers Dies from The Greetery). Card Stock Very Vanilla, Gray Granite, Pear Pizzazz (SU). Stick some pearls to the hanger as shown.
- 13) To complete the card front, stick some Rhinestones to the banner pieces and a 'scattering' over the 'open' section.





- 14) Inside-Middle Section Die-cut and assemble the small and medium sized hanging pots (Macro Made For You & Macro Made Fillers Dies from The Greetery). Card Stock Very Vanilla, Gray Granite, Garden Green, Mint Macaron (SU). Add some adhesive pearls to the hangers as shown. Attach the small hanging pot to the middle panel with foam squares and glue. Attach the top of the middle-sized hanging pot to the Box Insert with a couple of Glue Dots.
- 15) Stamp and fussy cut the living room chairs (Gray Granite Ink - SU, His & Hers Stamp Set - Catherine Pooler Designs). Attach both to the middle panel with foam adhesive squares.

16) Die-cut and assemble the Parlor Palms (Altenew) using Gray Granite patterned paper (In Good Taste DSP) for the pot and Mossy Meadow and Pear Pizzazz for the palm leaves. Attach the pot with a foam adhesive square to the far-right section of the card.







17) Stamp the envelope with a pot plant image (Pot Pourri Stamp set from The Greetery) using Gray Granite, Garden Green and Shaded Spruce Ink (SU). Personalise with stamped initials if desired.

This card will fold 'flattish' and fit inside a standard card size envelope.
