

'Friendly Hello' Tri-fold Card

Supplies -

Stamp Set: Friendly Hello (SALE-a-bration Jan/Feb 2022)

Card Stock: Basic White, Pool Party/Granny Apple Green or Petal Pink/Shaded Spruce

Ink: Memento Tuxedo Black, Shaded Spruce, Pool Party

DSP: Friendly Hello 12x12 (SALE-a-bration Jan/Feb 2022)

Dies: Stitched So Sweetly

Other: Basic White Envelopes

Tools and Adhesive: Paper Trimmer, Die-cutting Machine, Multipurpose Liquid Glue, Bone Folder, Suggested Clear Blocks for Friendly Hello photopolymer stamp set - a,b,c,d



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Cutting Dimensions –

Use either the measurements for **A4 Cardstock (centimetres)** or **Letter size Cardstock (inches)** and not a combination of both.

A4 Card Base –

Pool Party Cardstock – (H)14.8cm x (W)21cm

DSP Pieces for Card Front Panels –

(H)14.3cm x (W)6cm & (H)14.3cm x (W)3.5cm

Basic White Cardstock –

(H)14.3cm x (W)10cm

Granny Apple Green Cardstock –

Use the largest Stitched So Sweetly Rectangle Die to cut a scalloped rectangle OR if you don't have the die, cut a piece that measures, (H)10cm x (W)7.5cm.

Top DSP Piece –

Use the second largest Stitched So Sweetly Rectangle Die to cut a scalloped rectangle OR if you don't have the die, cut a piece that measures, (H)9cm x (W)6.5cm.

Instructions –

1. Score along the width of the card base at the **6.5cm** and **17cm** marks or **2-3/4"** and **7"** marks. Valley fold both score lines and crease with a Bone Folder.
2. Glue the DSP panels to the front of the card.



Letter size Card Base –

Petal Pink Cardstock – (H)5-1/2" x (W)8-1/2"

DSP Pieces for Card Front Panels –

(H)5-1/4" x (W)2-1/2" & (H)5-1/4" x (W)1-1/4"

Basic White Cardstock –

(H)5-1/4" x (W)4"

Shaded Spruce Cardstock –

Use the largest Stitched So Sweetly Rectangle Die to cut a scalloped rectangle OR if you don't have the die, cut a piece that measures, (H)4-1/8" x (W)2-7/8".

Top DSP Piece –

Use the second largest Stitched So Sweetly Rectangle Die to cut a scalloped rectangle OR if you don't have the die, cut a piece that measures, (H)3-5/8" x (W)2-3/8".



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3. Stamp a sentiment in the centre of the Basic White piece with Memento Tuxedo Black Ink.
4. Stamp the leafy image with Shaded Spruce or Granny Apple Green Ink, to the lower-left side as shown.
5. Glue the Basic White piece to the inside-middle panel.
6. As you can see from the card on the left, the stamps coordinate beautifully; they can be stamped directly onto the 'Granny Apple' floral DSP to add more detail. I used Shaded Spruce Ink for this example.
7. Glue the DSP scalloped rectangle to the larger one cut from cardstock. Place in the middle of the card front and glue to the left-front panel only.
8. To add a personal touch, stamp the envelope with an image of your choice using a coordinating ink colour (Shaded Spruce and Pool Party chosen for these examples).
