Bendy Tree Trunk Card

Stamp Set: Adorable Owls

Ink: Memento Tuxedo Black, Soft Suede Stampin' Blends: Crumb Cake, Cajun Craze, Rich Razzleberry, Pool Party and a Pumpkin

Pie Watercolor Pencil

Card Stock: Thick Basic White, Soft Suede,

Mossy Meadow DSP: Dainty Flowers

Dies: Dainty Delight, Meadow, Tree Rings Embossing Folders: Timber 3D, Tree Rings

Hybrid

Embellishments: Brushed Brass Butterflies Tools & Adhesives: Paper Trimmer, Paper Snips, Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, Sponge Dauber, Bone Folder, Multipurpose Liquid Glue, Stampin' Dimensionals, Tear & Tape Adhesive, Adhesive Foam Strips

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Non-SU: 6-1/4" square envelope

Instructions.

- Card Base Cut a 6"x6" piece of
 Thick Basic White Cardstock and make
 vertical score lines along the width at
 the 1-1/2" and 3" marks. Valley fold
 both score lines and crease with a
 Bone Folder.
- Cut a piece of DSP that measures (H)5-3/4" x (W)2-3/4" and glue to the right-hand panel (Ignore the incorrect, mountain fold, score line on the left).
- Sentiment Stamp a sentiment with Tuxedo Black Ink onto white cardstock and die-cut using a label die (Meadow). Snip off the right end and attach to the top-right section of the DSP with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 4. Bendy Tree Trunk Cut a piece of Soft Suede Cardstock that measures (H)5-3/4" x (W)4-3/4". Make vertical score lines along the width at the 1" and 3-3/4" marks. Mountain fold both score lines and crease with a Bone Folder.
- 5. Die-cut a hole in the tree trunk using a single die from the Tree Rings Hybrid Embossing Folder Dies.
- 6. Emboss the tree trunk piece with the Timber 3D Embossing Folder.









- Die-cut and emboss the largest single tree ring from Soft Suede Cardstock and sponge on some Soft Suede Ink (pictured on the left side in the photo).
- 8. Nest the single die used in step 5 within one of the slightly larger dies and die-cut to form a 'frame' for the hole in the tree trunk (pictured on the right side in the photo).
- Sponge the outer piece with Soft Suede Ink and glue to the tree hollow as shown.

- 10. Stamp an owl image with Memento Tuxedo Black Ink onto Thick Basic White Cardstock and color using Stampin' Blends Owl Body Crumb Cake Combo Eyes Cajun Craze Combo Bow Tie Rich Razzleberry Combo Beak and Feet Pumpkin Pie Watercolor Pencil Fussy cut with Paper Snips
- 11. Cut a small rectangular strip of Soft Suede Cardstock so it extends below the owl's body. Apply glue and attach to the back of the owl.







12. Position the owl and attach the extended piece to the inside of the tree trunk.

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
13. On the inside of the tree trunk, attach an Adhesive Foam Strip to the outer edge of the hole as shown.



14. With right side facing downward, stick the large, sponged tree ring to the adhesive foam strip.



15. Attach strips of Tear & Tape Adhesive to the outside of both 1" tabs.




16. Fold the tabs under and stick the tree trunk to the left-hand side of the card base so the tree trunk sits flat when the card lays flat and bends when it is 'opened'.



17. Die-cut a leafy branch from the Dainty Delight Dies with Mossy Meadow Cardstock. Lay the card flat and dab small amounts of glue to sections of the leafy branch and adhere to both sides of the card base as shown.



18. Fussy cut some flowers from the DSP and glue to the lower-left section of the tree trunk.



- 20. Stamp a flying owl to a 6-1/4" square envelope (non-SU) and color. Pop a piece of cardstock inside the envelope while you color the owl to prevent the ink from the Stampin' Blends seeping through. I used Pool Party instead of Cajun Craze for the eyes on this owl.
- 21. Push the card down so it sits flat to place inside an envelope.

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
