"Cheerful Daises" Double Z-Fold Box Card

Cutting Mensurements:

A4 -Card Base (Boho Blue) -(H)10.5cm × (W)29.6cm Back Panel (Basic White) -(H)10cm × (W)14.3cm DSP (Fresh as a Daisy) -(H)10cm × (W)6.9cm (x2), (H)10cm × (W)14.3cm Box Inserts (Garden Green) - (x2) (H)4cm × (W)9.4cm Box Inserts (DSP) - (x2) (H)4cm × (W)7.4cm Z-Fold Pieces (Garden Green & DSP) -(H)4.5cm × (W)29.6cm

Instructions

- Card Base Score along the width of the Card Base at -
- 7.4cm and 14.8cm or
- 2-3/4" and 5-1/2".


L-R: Mountain Fold the first score line, Valley Fold the second.

- Glue on the DSP panels to each section of the card base keeping continuity of pattern from left to right.
- Box Inserts Score in 1cm or ½" on both ends of the Garden Green box inserts. Mountain fold the first score line and valley fold the second. Attach some Tear & Tape Adhesive to the outside of both tabs.
- 4) Glue on the DSP pieces to the box inserts.
- 5) Cut some curvy grass mounds along the top edge of the box inserts with Paper Snips.

US Letter Size – Card Base (Boho Blue) – $(H)4-1/4" \times (W)11"$ Back Panel (Basic White) – $(H)4" \times (W) 5-1/4"$ DSP (Fresh as a Daisy) – $(H)4" \times (W)2-1/2" (X2), (H)4" \times (W) 5-1/4"$ Box Inserts (Garden Green) – (x2) $(H)1-1/2" \times (W)3-3/4"$ Box Inserts (DSP) – (x2) $(H)1-1/2" \times (W)2-3/4"$


Z-Fold Pieces (Garden Green & DSP) – (H)1-3/4" \times (W)11"





- 6) Attach the left tabs on the inserts to the middle section of the card as shown. Line them up so they are level with the bottom edge of the card.
- 7) Place some Tear & Tape Adhesive along the lower edge of the far-left and far-right of the card base as shown.
- Z-Fold Piece Glue the DSP piece to the Garden Green piece. Score along the width of the Z-Fold piece at
- 14.8cm and 22.2cm or
- 5-1/2" and 8-1/4". Mountain fold the first score line, valley fold the second.
- Flatten down the whole card, including the box inserts. Turn up the end tabs and remove the top layer of tape.
- Cut some curvy grass mounds along the top edge of the Z-Fold piece with Paper Snips.
- Attach the Z-Fold piece along the lower edge so it sticks to the Tear & Tape Adhesive and the tabs on the box inserts. Open up the card; it should look like the example below -







- 12) Daisies Die-cut the cluster of daisies (#14) from some Garden Green Cardstock and attach to the card front with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 13) Die-cut 3 single daisies from Basic White Cardstock (#2, #3 and #4) and glue each one to the cluster of daisies as shown.
- 14) Die-cut 3 single, embossed daisies from Basic White Cardstock (#1, #7 and #8) and glue each one to the plain, single daisies.
- 15) Die-cut two leaves from Pretty Peacock Cardstock (#13) and glue to the back of the leaves.
- 16) Die-cut a total of 6 branches from Pretty Peacock Cardstock (#11). Glue three of them to the card front as shown.
- 17) Stamp and die-cut a total of 7 flower centres (5 small and 2 large) using Crushed Curry Ink on Basic White Cardstock. Glue 2 small and 1 large one to the centres on each of the flowers in the front cluster (#5 and #12).



- 18) Stamp a sentiment (Sentimental Park) onto a scrap of Basic White Card Stock with Tuxedo Black Ink and diecut using the small label die (#9) from Cheerful Daisies. Fold the card downwards so you can evenly glue the label to the middle-right side of the card as shown.
- 19) Take the three remaining branches and glue one to the front box insert, one to the back box insert and one to the far-right side of the card.
- 20) Die-cut, stamp and assemble four more daisies (# 3, #5 & #7) [x2], (#4, #5, #6, & #8) and (#1, #2 & #12) and attach to the card as suggested.
- 21) Back Panel Glue the Basic White Panel to the back of the card.
- 22) Envelope Die-cut the cluster of daisies (#14) from some Basic White Cardstock and glue to the lower-left side of the envelope (not suitable for posting; hand delivery only).



23) To close the card, swing the front section down towards the right and place inside a standard card size envelope (C6 or Medium).





US Lettersize Version

Made using the largest and fourth largest Deckled Rectangles Dies for the background DSP, a sentiment from Cheerful Daisies and different layering of the daisy dies. Flower centres and rhinestones were coloured with Daffodil Delight Stampin' Blends.
