Supplies:

Stamp Set: Garden Meadow

Ink: Early Espresso, Tuxedo Black

Stampin' Blends: Melon Mambo, Crumb Cake, Granny Apple Green

Cardstock: Granny Apple Green, Basic White, Melon Mambo, Crushed Curry, Early Espresso
Designer Series Paper: 6x6 Meandering Meadows

Dies: Garden Meadow (arch), Paper Florist (flowers), Give It A Whirl (label)

Other: 6" Square Envelope (non-SU)

Tools & Adhesives: Multipurpose Liquid Glue, Stampin' Dimensionals, Paper Trimmer, Die-Cutting Machine, Bone Folder



Paper Florist Dies

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Cutting Measurements:

Card Base (Granny Apple Green Cardstock) –
(H) 5-1/2" x (L) 11"

DSP (Meandering Meadows) Mats –
(H) 5-1/4" x (W) 5-1/4" (x2 identical) and
Basic White Cardstock (x1)

Instructions:

- 1) **Card Base** – Score along the length at the 5-1/2" mark to form a square card base. Fold and crease the score line with a Bone Folder.
- 2) Glue one DSP mat to the card front and the other, identical one, to the inside of the card.
- 3) **Window** – Die-cut an arch in the card front.
- 4) **Card Back** – Stamp the basket of flowers to the Basic White Card Mat with Memento Tuxedo Black Ink and colour with Stampin' Blends. Glue to the card back.
- 5) **Adding the Die-Cut Foliage** – Die-cut the following pieces from the Paper Florist Dies (refer to chart on first page):
 - #16 Die – Melon Mambo Cardstock – 2 larger flowers, 4 smaller flowers
 - #14 Die – Crushed Curry Cardstock – 3 smaller flower centres
 - #4 Die – Early Espresso Cardstock x3
 - #11 Die – Granny Apple Green Cardstock x4 (one trimmed)



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- 6) **Sentiment** – Stamp the Happy Birthday sentiment with Early Espresso Ink and die-cut using the small label from the Give It a Whirl Dies.
- 7) Assemble and attach the foliage and label as shown with glue; pop a Stampin’ Dimensional underneath the larger flower.
- 8) **Envelope** – Stamp the flower basket image onto the bottom, left-hand corner of an envelope and colour with Stampin’ Blends (Place a piece of scrap cardstock inside the envelope to prevent the ink from the blends seeping through to the back of the envelope).
