1. Cut a piece of Kraft Cardstock that measures (L)21cm x (W)13cm or (L)8-1/2" x (W)5".

2. Score along the length at the halfway mark (10.5cm or 4-1/4"). Mountain fold the score line and crease with a Bone Folder.

3. Place the **second largest** Stitched Hexagon Die just slightly above the folded edge of the easel base. Run it through the die-cutting machine to form the hexagon easel card base.

4. Die-cut a single plain hexagon from Kraft Cardstock with the second largest die.

5. Make a horizontal score line along the middle on the front piece of the hexagon easel card base and fold the bottom section downwards.

6. Add glue to the lower, folded section of the card base and attach the single Kraft hexagon die-cut.









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7. Die-cut two hexagon shapes from patterned paper using the **third largest** Stitched Hexagon Die. Glue one to the top hexagon ...

8. ... and one to the base of the card as shown.

9. Stamp a sentiment onto the embossed die-cut label with StazOn Ink. Attach to the middle of the card base with adhesive foam dots. Stick a gem to each side of the label.

10. Attach two butterfly embossed die-cuts to either side of the card with foam dots.



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11. Die-cut a hexagon from white cardstock using the **third largest** Stitched Hexagon Die. Glue to the underside of the card base. This is where you can write a note to the recipient.



12. To close the card, fold down the top hexagon onto the card base and pop inside a C6 envelope. Optional: Glue an embossed die-cut to the envelope.
