1. Start with a standard card size base (made from half a sheet of A4 or US Lettersize) and die-cut a hexagon window in the lower right corner with the die from the Confetti Jar 1 Metal Cutting Dies.

Important Note: The hexagon die from this set has sides that differ in length so they all need to be positioned the same way.

2. Die-cut a sentiment from the paper collection, nest it inside the hexagon window and glue it in place inside the card.

3. Die-cut 10 hexagons from scraps of patterned paper and glue them into position as suggested, leaving a small gap between each one.

4. Trim off any pieces that extend beyond the edges of the card front.

5. Attach an embossed bee die-cut to the card with a foam dot.

6. Optional: Glue another patterned hexagon to the envelope.
