Supplies -

Cardstock: White

6x6 Paper Collections:

Bees & Butterflies [33558] and

Bees & Butterflies Basics [33582]

Embossed Die-Cuts:

Bees & Butterflies [33585]

Metal Cutting Dies: Confetti Jar 1 [25411]

Other: Natural Linen Thread, Crystal Sticks

Notecard Envelope

Tools and Adhesive: Paper Trimmer, Die Cutting Machine, Scoring Board, Foam Dots, Art Glitter Glue, Bone Folder, Scissors

Instructions -

1. Cut a piece of white cardstock that measures – (L)19cm/7-1/2" x (W)8cm/3-1/4". Score along the long side at the halfway mark – 9.5cm/3-3/4" to form a Portrait Card Base.
2. Mountain fold the score line and crease with a Bone Folder.
3. Position the top of the Confetti Jar 1 Metal Cutting Die just slightly above the folded edge and die-cut to form the card base.
4. Make a horizontal score line along the middle on the front piece of the card and fold the bottom section downwards to form an easel.
5. With the same die, cut one jar from white cardstock and one from patterned paper. Glue the patterned piece to the white piece.
6. Stick the jar to the lower, folded section of the easel card base with glue.
7. Die-cut two frilly jar lid covers. Glue both jar lid covers together along the top section (above the cut-out line).



8. Glue down the back of the jar lid cover to the card back.



9. Glue down the front jar lid cover to the card front.



10. Take an embossed die-cut tab and trim off both ends that stick out. Stick to the middle of the card base with foam dots to create the easel stopper.



11. Die-cut a tag from patterned paper and wrap some linen thread around the jar lid cover.

12. Add some Crystal Stickers to the centre of all the flowers on the jar and tag. Leave to dry.
13. To close the card, fold down the jar onto the card base and pop inside a notecard envelope.
