Supplies -

Cardstock: White

6x6 Paper Collections:

Bees & Butterflies [33558] and
Bees & Butterflies Basics [33582]

Embossed Die-Cuts:

Bees & Butterflies [33585]

Metal Cutting Dies: Confetti Jar 1 [25411]

Other: Natural Linen Thread,
Notecard Envelope

Tools and Adhesive: Paper Trimmer, Die
Cutting Machine, Foam Dots, Art Glitter
Glue, Bone Folder, Scissors



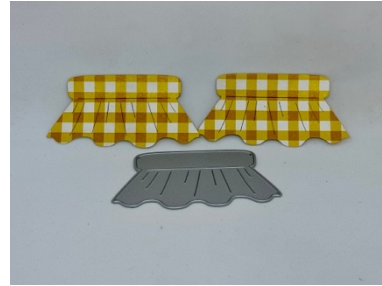

Instructions -

1. Cut a piece of white cardstock that measures – (L)19cm/7-1/2" x (W)8cm/3-1/4". Score along the long side at the halfway mark – 9.5cm/3-3/4" to form a Portrait Card Base.
2. Mountain fold the score line and crease with a Bone Folder.
3. Position the top of the Confetti Jar 1 Metal Die just slightly above the folded edge and die-cut.
4. With the same die, cut one piece of patterned paper ...
5. ... and use the die to cut out the 'honey label' embossed die-cut.
6. Glue both pieces to the card front as shown. Snip off the overhang at the top.



7. Die-cut two frilly jar lid covers.



8. Glue the two jar lid covers together along the top section (above the cut-out line).



9. Glue down the back of the jar lid cover to the card back.



10. Add foam dots underneath the front jar lid cover and stick down.



11. Glue the middle section of the honey dipper embossed die-cut to the jar lid cover as shown. Wrap around some linen thread and finish by tying a bow in the middle.

12. Attach two embossed die-cut bees to the card front with foam dots.

13. Optional: Decorate the back of the note card envelope with an embossed die-cut.
