Instructions -

1. Cut a piece of Yellow Cardstock from A4 - (H)14.8cm x (W)10.5cm or Letter size - (H)5-1/2" x (W)4-1/4".
2. Cut a piece of patterned paper - (H)14.3cm x (W)10cm or (H)5-1/4" x (W)4".
3. Ink the edges of the patterned paper and glue to the yellow card base.
4. Cut a piece of yellow cardstock, (L)13cm x (W)10.5cm or (L)5" x (W)4-1/4". Score along the length at the halfway mark (6.5cm or 2-1/2"). Mountain fold the score line and crease with a Bone Folder.
5. Align the **large** Alora plain butterfly die just slightly above the folded edge of the easel base. Run it through the die-cutting machine to form the butterfly easel card base.
6. Die-cut a single plain butterfly from yellow cardstock and one from patterned paper.
7. Make a horizontal score line along the middle on the front piece of the butterfly easel card base and fold the bottom section of the butterfly downwards.
8. Add glue to the lower, folded section of the butterfly card base and attach the single yellow butterfly die-cut. Glue the patterned butterfly die-cut to the yellow die-cut.
9. Repeat steps 4 to 8 with the **largest and second largest** butterfly dies from the trio.
Yellow cardstock - (L)11cm x (W)8.5cm or (L)4-1/4" x (W)3-1/2".
Score line - 5.5cm or 2-1/8".
Yellow cardstock - (L)8cm x (W)7cm or (L)3-1/4" x (W)2-3/4".
Score line - 4cm or 1-5/8".



10. Die-cut the three detailed butterflies from Gold Shimmer Cardstock and glue each one to the abdomen of the large, medium and small patterned paper butterflies.

11. Stick three adhesive backed rhinestones onto each abdomen.

12. Glue the bottom of the large butterfly easel card to the top (back) of the card base, about 7mm or 1/4" down from the top edge of the patterned paper.

13. Space the medium and small butterfly easel cards evenly and glue to the card base as shown.

14. Stamp a sentiment onto the embossed die-cut label with StazOn Ink. Attach to the lower edge of the card base with adhesive foam dots.

15. To close the card, fold all three butterflies down 'flat' onto the card base and pop inside a card size envelope.
