## Supplies -

**Cardstock:** 12x12 Cherry Blossom Pink Smooth [32847], A5 Golden Dream Shimmer [29751], White

**6x6 Paper Collections:**

Easter Village [34038],

Easter Village Basics [34062]

**Embossed Die-Cuts:** Easter Village [34065]

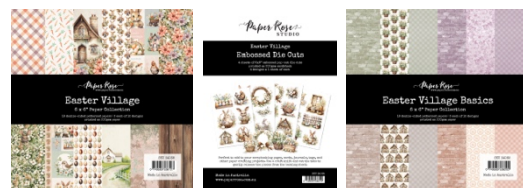
**Metal Cutting Dies:**

Lots of Eggs [18724], Pierced Rectangles

[21438], Mini Alphabet & Numbers [17952]

**Other:** Adhesive Pearls, White Envelope

**Tools and Adhesive:** Paper Trimmer, Scoring Board, Die Cutting Machine, Adhesive Foam Dots, Art Glitter Glue, Bone Folder



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## Cutting Dimensions -

### Cherry Blossom Pink Cardstock -

Card Base - (H)5-1/2" x (W)4-1/4" (or use the largest Pierced Rectangle Die)

Zig Zag Piece - (H)2-3/4" x (W)12"

White Cardstock - (H)4-3/8" x (W)3-1/8" (or use the second largest Pierced Rectangle Die)

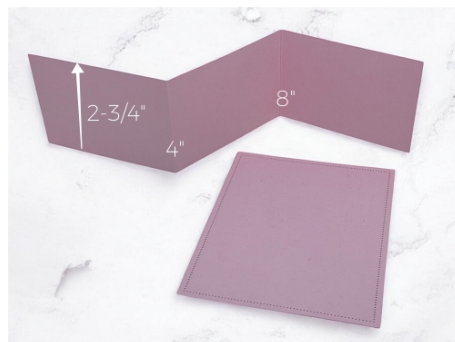
### Easter Village Paper -

Card Base - (H)4-3/8" x (W)3-1/8" (or use the second largest Pierced Rectangle Die)

Zig-Zag Pieces - Pink floral (x2) and green floral (x2) each measuring (H)2-9/16" x (W)3-13/16" (or use the fourth largest Pierced Rectangle Die)

## Instructions -

- 1) Score along the width of the zig-zag piece at 4" and 8". From L-R, mountain fold and valley fold the score lines. Crease with a Bone Folder.
- 2) Glue the right panel of the zig-zag piece to the lower section of the card base (so the pierced dots are visible).
- 3) Glue the large piece of Easter Village Paper to the card base.
- 4) Glue the four zig-zag floral paper pieces to the card as shown.
- 5) Glue the white cardstock piece to the back of the card base. This is where you can write a message to the recipient.



- 6) Die-cut a gingham egg using the largest Lots of Eggs Metal Cutting Die and glue to the card base as shown.



- 7) Die-cut two pink gingham eggs using the second largest Lots of Eggs Metal Cutting Die. Glue one to the back and one to the 'front' of the middle panel so the egg 'nests' over the large one when the card is closed.



- 8) Die-cut two mauve gingham eggs using the third largest Lots of Eggs Metal Cutting Die. Glue one to the back and one to the front of the front panel so the egg 'nests' over the middle one when the card is closed.



- 9) Attach some cute embossed die-cuts to the card with adhesive foam dots (see pictures for suggested placement).

- 10) Stick some pearls to the flower centres on the front embossed die-cut (bunny) and on the cluster of flowers embossed die-cut at the 'back' on the largest egg.



11) Glue the bird's nest embossed die-cut to the lower-left corner of an envelope.

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
